Surprise Donation for Homeless Ministry

Thanks to a generous benefactor from our community, ASLC received a check for \$1,500 to be used to minister to the homeless in 2018. The Family Life Mission Team has decided to break this up into six projects, hoping we can get matching funds of \$250 for each project we do through Thrivent Financial's Action Grants. If we can get approval for all six projects, we can double the amount of money we have to work with for a total of \$3000!!! Our first project will be Abba's House which is a new ministry of the Western Carolina Rescue Ministries whom we help with the Coat Drive in the Fall. Abba's House is designed to help mothers and their infants obtain the recovery they need from substance abuse. It's a 12 month residential program and they have 14 mother/baby rooms plus a common area for meals, fellowship, and learning.

Valentine's Day, Feb 14, is also Ash Wednesday. We will do the imposition of ashes and Holden Evening Prayer at 7:00pm. We hope you'll join us for this powerful worship service.
