However, based on the Financial Secretary's report for November we have some good news: Monthly income for Nov was \$11,410! If we average the 2017 budget, it comes to \$9,645.50 per month. That makes an approximate gain of **+1,765.50** for Nov which will help to make up some of our deficit for the year. Thank you for your generous support of our church.
